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Mount Hutton Public School Excursion Procedures

Overview:
Excursions are an integral part of learning experiences at Mount Hutton Public School. Excursions are structured learning experiences, provided by the school which can be conducted both internally and externally for the school site. They are planned, the safety and procedures are checked at every stage. All school excursion offerings are subject to the same policy and procedure guidelines.

School excursions include:

- Local visits outside the school grounds, which may be planned or spontaneous.
- Local excursions which are both a day in duration and do not involve overnight accommodation.
- Major excursions involving overnight accommodation.
- Virtual excursions accessed through computer equipment.
- Excursions which are visits and events organised within the school grounds.

Purpose of School Excursion Procedures:
These procedures outline the guiding principles for the organisation of excursions, virtual excursions and excursions, and the implementation of the New South Wales Department of Education's (NSW DET) policy and procedures for managing these experiences.

Planning and Sustainability of School Excursions:
In the planning of excursions, staff at Mount Hutton Public School will give consideration to:

- the educational value, viability of the excursion and the total number of planned activities each year
- cost implications for the school and community
- potential attraction for learning and outcomes of the school
- potential for ongoing student experience by use of school and/or P&C subsidy to reduce the cost of excursions for all participating students
- sustainability of excursion offering and assessing for whether the excursion is offered each year, every second year, or on a three year cycle or as a one off excursion
- availability of staff to ensure appropriate supervision of students at all times
- availability of staff for major overnight excursions which require extended overnight stays
- maximising excursion offerings if budget numbers are not met
- potential for the offering of referrals for non-attendance where feasible, however not guaranteed
- availability of transport including cost of hire and/or private transport costs
- maximising student experience in the event private transport is required but is not available or budget requirements for private transport are not met

Come to 'All Around Australia' and see if we visit there too.

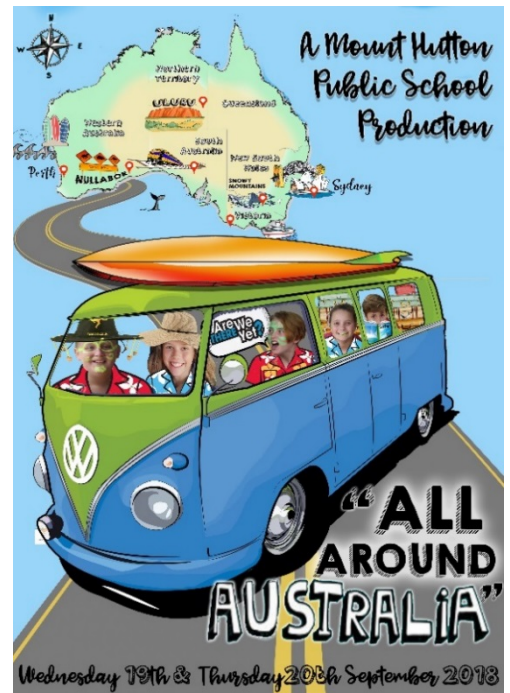

School Swimming & Water Safety Program

All Students in Years 2 – 6 have taken home a note about our involvement in the Intensive School Swimming and Water Safety Program.

The School Swimming and Water Safety Program is an intensive instructional swimming and water safety program designed for students in Years 2 – 6, regardless of swimming ability.

Students who have not currently reached a satisfactory standard of water safety are actively encouraged to participate in the program. Notes are due back to school by Tuesday, 25 September.

NAPLAN Online School Readiness Test (SRT)

We are excited to announce that our school will be transitioning to NAPLAN Online in 2019. As part of this transition, we are currently administering a NAPLAN Online School Readiness Test (SRT). The SRT is intended to enable us to confirm our technical capacity and to assist in determining the most effective way to deliver NAPLAN Online in our school next year. Testing is being conducted over a three week period.

The SRT contains the following sample online tests:

- Omnibus test – for Years 3 and 5. This includes questions from the Reading, Conventions of Language and Numeracy domains.
- Writing test – for Year 5.

Please note that Year 3 students are only able to complete the Omnibus test, as the Year 3 Writing test will continue to be a pen and paper assessment in 2019.

It is important to remember that the SRT is not a formal assessment and students will not be graded for any of the tests. However, student participation will assist in our school confirming that we are ready for NAPLAN Online. Students have been thoroughly engaged in the online NAPLAN platform!
