Last Thursday, Students at Mount Hutton Public School came dressed in their spookiest costumes.

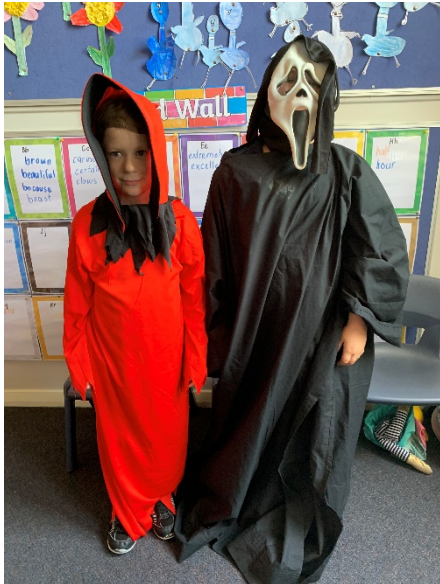


Students had the opportunity to buy I-SCREEAAMS during lunch time to raise money for the Year 6 Farewell.
