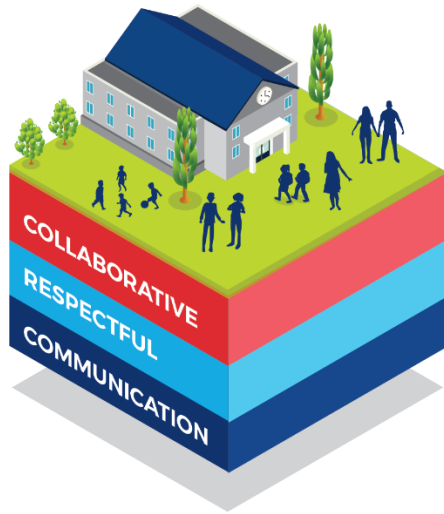

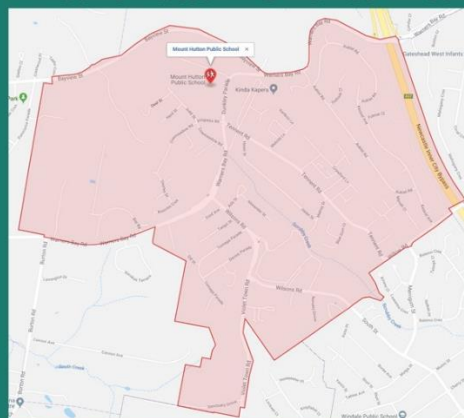

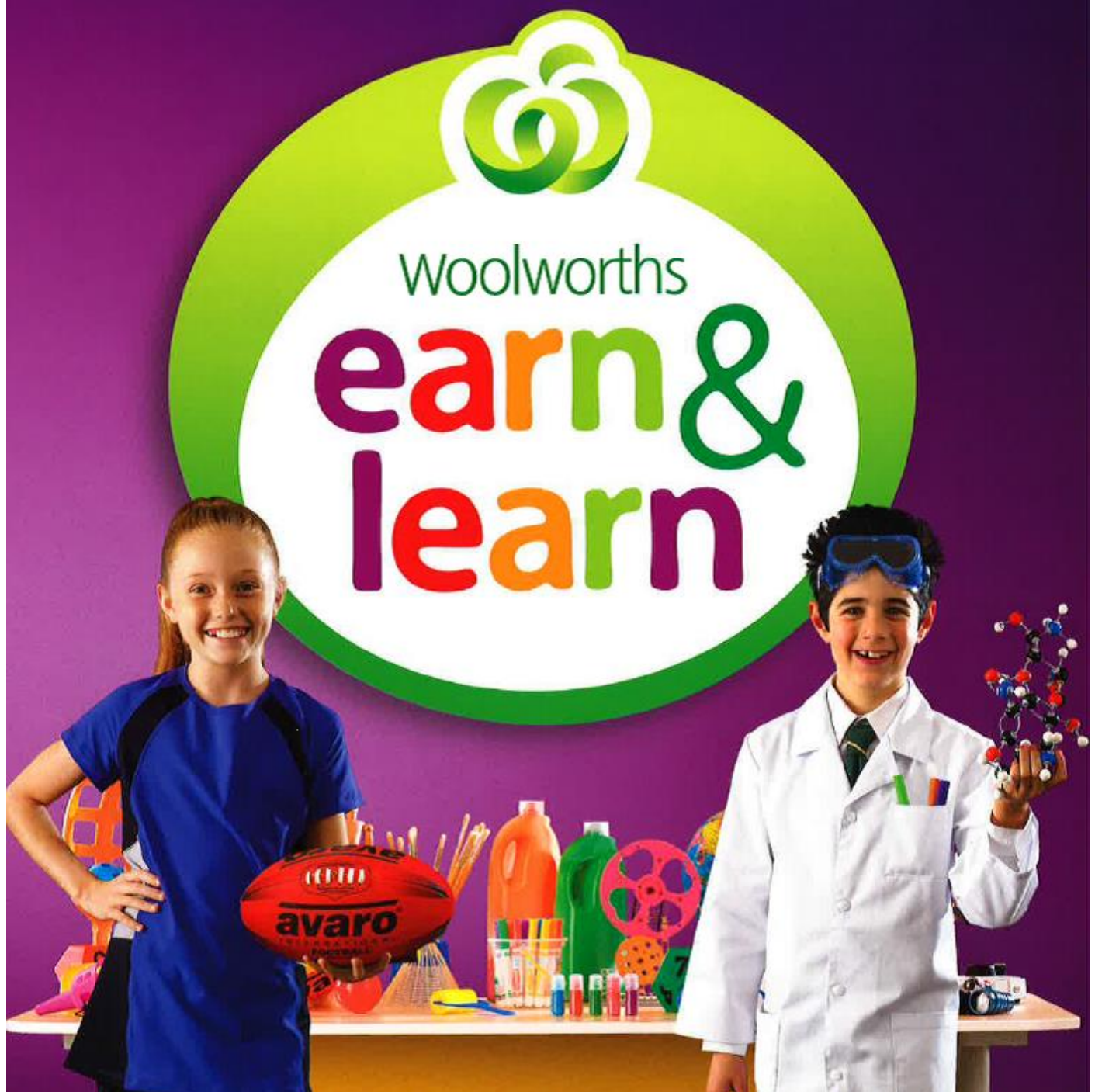

You could win a holiday!

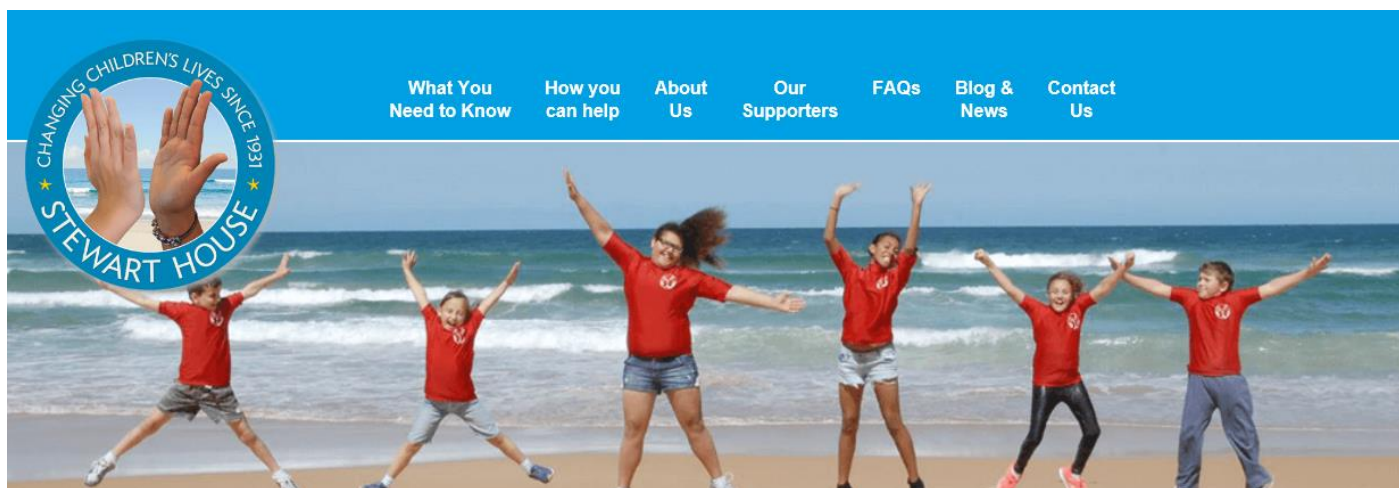


Mount Hutton Public School is holding a \$2.00 out of uniform day on Monday, 13 May, in order to show our support for Stewart House.

Your child's \$2.00 donation will automatically put you in the drawer for a chance to win a \$4000 holiday to a destination of your choice. All entry forms will be completed by class teachers.

Over the past two years, Mount Hutton Public School has had three children attend Stewart House. Every year, 1700 public school children attend Stewart House next to Curl Curl Beach at no cost to their parents or carers. During a child's 12 day stay they are provided with dental, optical, hearing and medical screening and treatment. Children participate in educational programs and excursions designed to develop their social and emotional skills, build self – esteem and improve their overall wellbeing.
