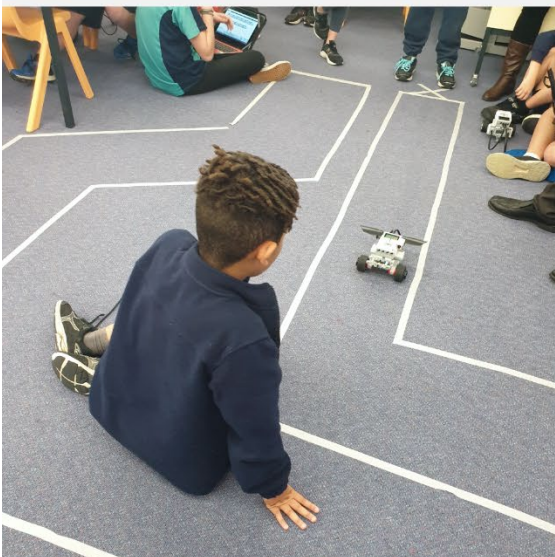
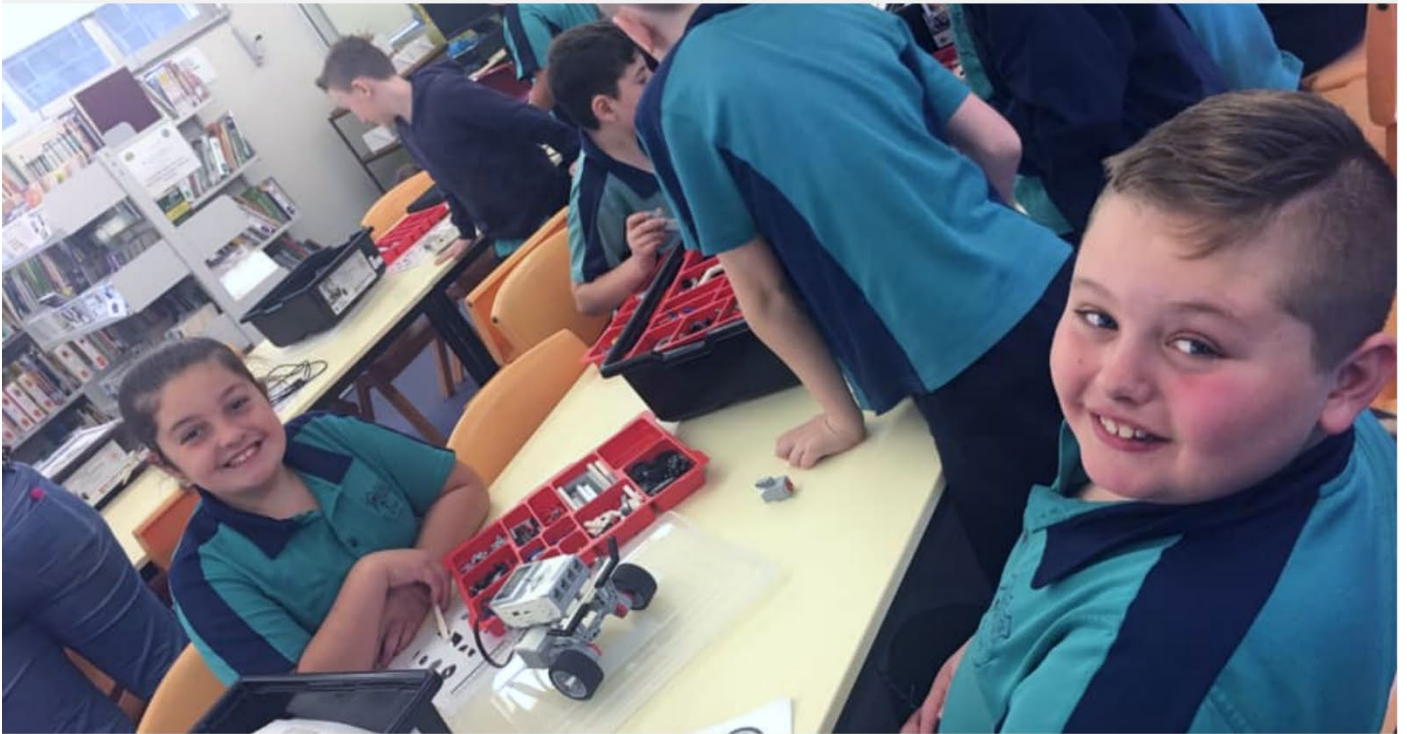

Library Updates

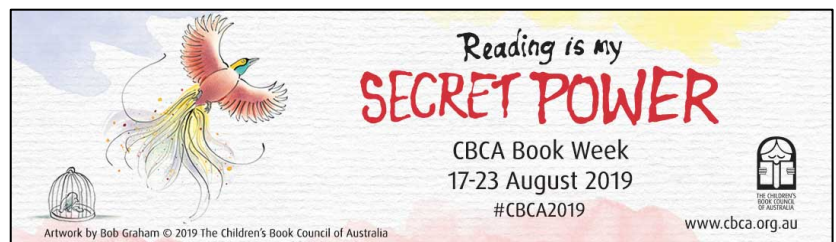

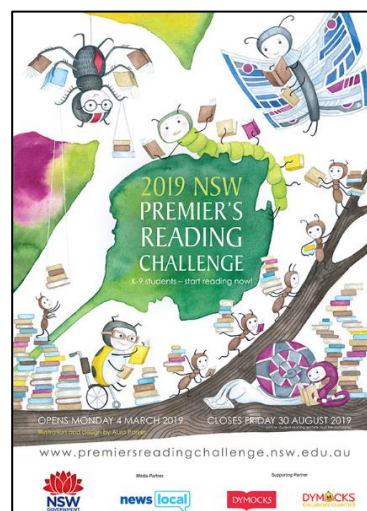


Save the Date – Book Week Parade – Thursday August 29
